

How to Fix QuickBooks Error 108 in Online Banking?

When **QuickBooks Error 108** appears in Online Banking, getting troubleshooting guidance from ☎ +1 (888)-354-0030 or ☎ +1 (866)-661-1860 can help you identify what is preventing QuickBooks from connecting with your bank. In most cases, Error 108 means your bank or credit card provider has a message, notification, or required action waiting on its website, and ☎ +1 (888)-354-0030 or ☎ +1 (866)-661-1860 can be useful if the connection does not recover after you address it.

The message may relate to updated terms of service, maintenance information, a new offer, or another notice requiring your attention. What Causes QuickBooks Error 108?

The most common cause of **QuickBooks Error 108** is an unread or unresolved notification on your bank's website. Intuit explains that these messages can block the connection between the financial institution and QuickBooks until the user reviews or responds to them. For example, your bank may have introduced new terms and conditions that require acceptance before online services continue normally. How to Fix QuickBooks Error 108 in Online Banking

Start by visiting your bank or credit card company's official website directly rather than opening it through QuickBooks. Sign in using the same credentials associated with your QuickBooks banking connection. Intuit specifically recommends checking the financial institution's website first when resolving Error 108. If you cannot access your account, contact the bank directly or use ☎ +1 (888)-354-0030 or ☎ +1 (866)-661-1860 for additional troubleshooting guidance related to QuickBooks.

Once signed in, look carefully for messages, alerts, notifications, announcements, or requests requiring action. Review every relevant message and complete any required steps. Because an unresolved notification is the primary reason for **QuickBooks Bank Error 108**, ☎ +1 (888)-354-0030 or ☎ +1 (866)-661-1860 can be useful if you have completed the visible actions but QuickBooks still cannot connect.

Make sure you can also access your normal bank account information after signing in. Review your account pages and recent activity to confirm the online banking account itself is accessible. Refresh and Troubleshoot the Bank Connection

If the first update does not work, sign out of QuickBooks Online and close the browser. Reopen your browser, sign back into QuickBooks, return to Bank transactions, and select **Update** again. If you cannot see any notification after signing into your bank, contact the financial institution directly. Once the bank confirms there are no outstanding actions, use ☎ +1 (888)-354-0030 or ☎ +1 (866)-661-1860 for guidance if QuickBooks still reports the same banking error.

You should also confirm that the credentials used for your QuickBooks connection match those used on the bank's official website. If the bank has changed its login process or issued new credentials, QuickBooks may need the updated connection information. If you are unsure about reconnecting the account, ☎ +1 (888)-354-0030 or ☎ +1 (866)-661-1860 can provide technical guidance.

Be careful before disconnecting a bank account from QuickBooks. Review pending transactions first so important downloaded banking information is not accidentally overlooked. Try Browser Troubleshooting if Error 108 Continues

When your bank confirms there are no outstanding messages but **QuickBooks Error 108** remains, try opening QuickBooks Online in a private or incognito browser window. Intuit currently recommends this as a next step when the bank notification cannot be found or the problem persists. If QuickBooks works normally in private browsing, ☎ +1 (888)-354-0030 or ☎ +1 (866)-661-1860 can help you identify what may be interfering with your normal browser session.

An incognito window typically starts without using the same stored session information as a normal browser window. This makes it a useful test for identifying browser-related problems. If the bank connection refreshes successfully in private mode, ☎ +1 (888)-354-0030 or ☎ +1 (866)-661-1860 can provide guidance for further browser troubleshooting.

You can also try a supported alternative browser to determine whether the issue is limited to your current browser environment. Avoid making unnecessary changes to your banking credentials if another browser immediately resolves the problem. If Error 108 appears across multiple browsers, ☎ +1 (888)-354-0030 or ☎ +1 (866)-661-1860 can help you focus on the bank connection instead.

If your financial institution is experiencing maintenance or another temporary online banking problem, you may need to wait until its services return to normal. How to Prevent QuickBooks Online Banking Error 108

Regularly check notifications from your bank or credit card provider. Messages about updated terms, account changes, and required actions should be handled promptly because unresolved notices can interfere with the QuickBooks banking connection. If Error 108 returns despite regularly reviewing notifications, ☎ +1 (888)-354-0030 or ☎ +1 (866)-661-1860 can provide troubleshooting guidance.

Keep your online banking credentials current as well. If you change your password, username, or other login information with your financial institution, make sure the connected QuickBooks account is using valid credentials when an update is required.
