Parrot Lookout Wildfire #R21234 EVACUATION ORDER ISSUED July 09, 2023 at 1200 hours

An Evacuation Order has been issued by Wet'suwet'en First Nation, Skin Tyee Nation and the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako effective **July 09, 2023 at 1200** hours due to a wildfire.

Because of the **danger to life and health**, Skin Tyee Nation, Wet'suwet'en First Nation and the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako have issued an Evacuation Order **for all properties and lands on the north side of Francois Lake**, **accessed off Colleymount Road (including all local roads)**, **between Trout Creek Road**, and the west end of Francois Lake, as shown on the attached map.

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY AND REGISTER AT THE RECEPTION CENTRE

Persons who disregard this Evacuation Order and remain in the Evacuation Order area do so at their own risk. The Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako may be unable to assist anyone who remains in the Evacuation Order area.

- ➤ If you need transportation assistance from the area, please advise the individual providing this notice or call the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako at **250-692-1553**.
- Close all windows and doors.
- > Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- > Gather your family: take a neighbour or someone who needs help.
- > Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on a leash.
- Do not use more vehicles than you must.


