# TWEEDSMUIR COMPLEX WILDFIRES PARTIAL EVACUATION ORDER RESCIND August 30, 2018 at 1230 hours

A **portion** of the Evacuation Order issued on **August 18, 2018 at 1200** by the Regional District of Bulkley Nechako is rescinded and an **Evacuation Alert** remains in place for the following area:

- **A portion south of Ootsa Lake and Whitesail Lake (as shown on the attached map)**
- **A portion south of the Nechako reservoir to the southern boundary of the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako (as shown on the attached map)**

An **Evacuation Order** remains in effect for:

- **North and South of Eutsuk Lake to the southern boundary of the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako including Jim Smith Point (see attached map).**

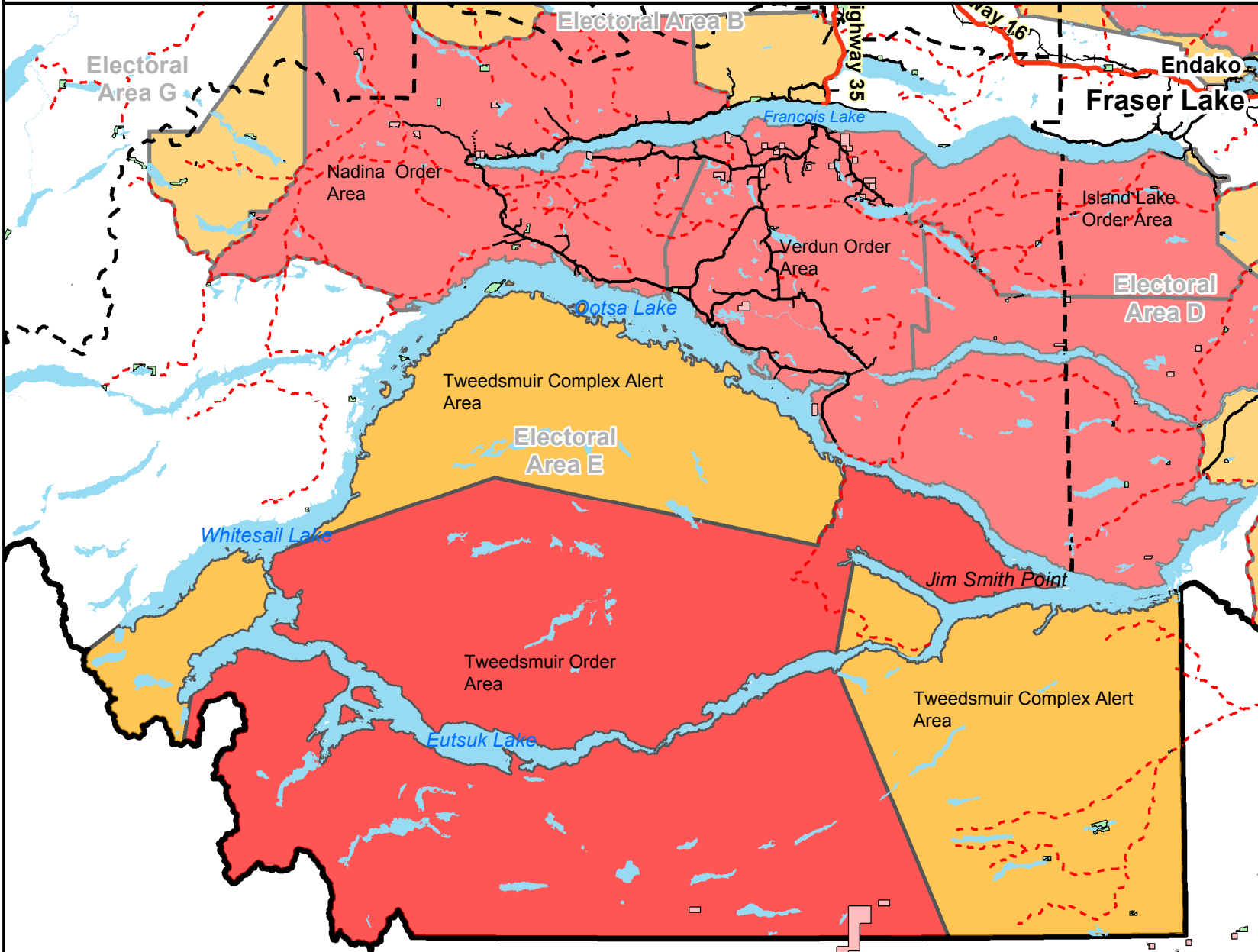
