

## NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY USE PERMIT

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako will be considering the issuance of a Temporary Use Permit at a meeting to be held during business hours on Thursday, September 19, 2019 in the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako Board Room, 37-3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Burns Lake, B.C. Please contact the Regional District to find out the start time of the meeting if you plan to attend.

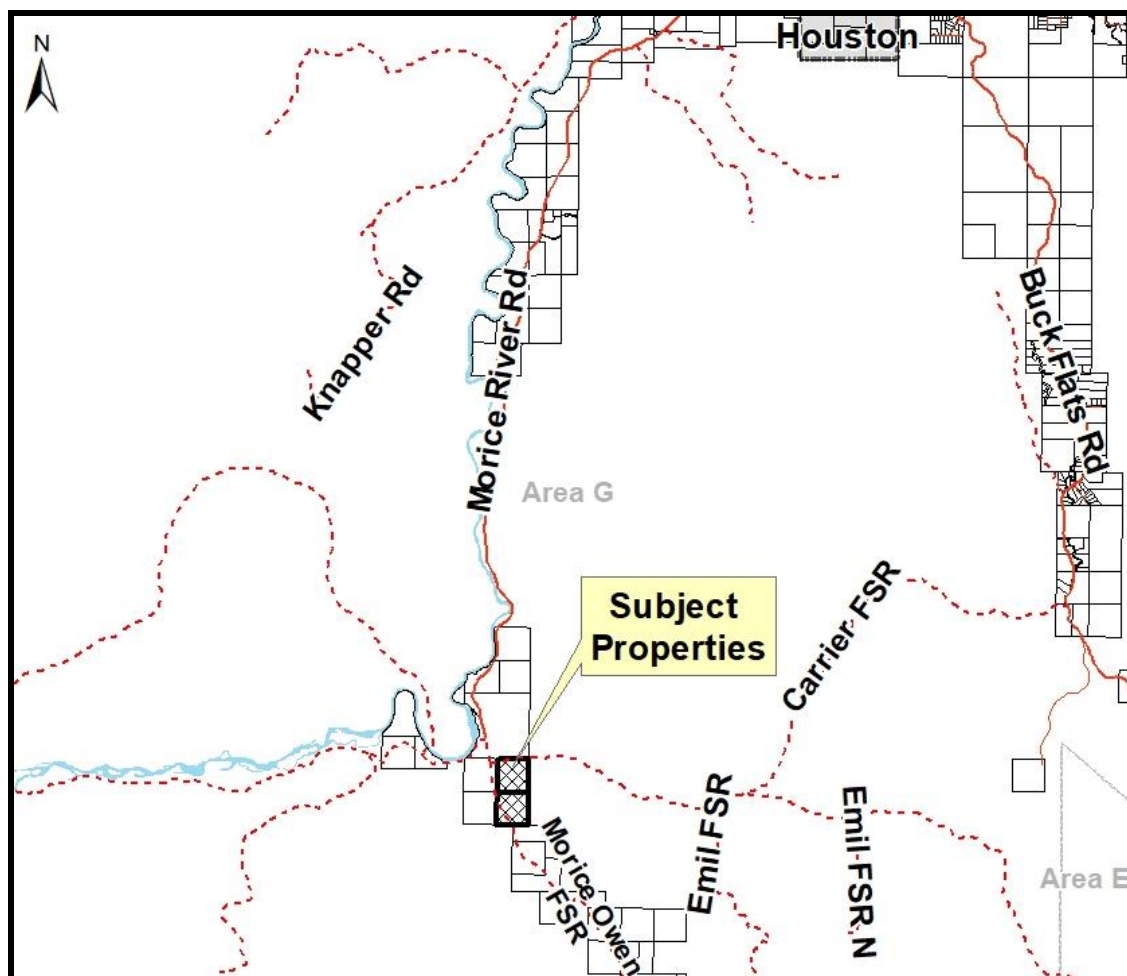
Pursuant to Section 493 of the *Local Government Act*, a Regional District Board may allow temporary uses for a period of three years or less, extendable for up to another three years, through the issuance of a Temporary Use Permit (TUP) by Board resolution.

An application has been made for a TUP to allow a work camp providing accommodations for up to 800 people and an equipment storage area at the location shown on the location map below. This area is referred to as the Huckleberry Multi-Use Site and is proposed to support the construction of the Coastal GasLink (CGL) Pipeline Project.

The subject properties are zoned Rural Resource (RR1). The RR1 zone does not allow the proposed equipment storage yard, or work camp accommodation uses. Therefore, the applicant is requesting the issuance of a TUP to allow the operation of the proposed work camp and a portion of the equipment storage yard.

The subject properties (Northeast and Southeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sections of District Lot 3408, Range 5, Coast District) are located on Morice Owen and Carrier Forest Service Roads (FSR), 25 km south of the District of Houston shown cross-hatched and labelled "Subject Properties" on the map below.

At the meeting all persons who deem their interests to be affected by this application will be given an opportunity to be heard or to present a written submission respecting matters contained in the application. A copy of the proposed permit and associated information will also be made available at the Houston Public Library.
