Subject: Purchase of a Used Excavator for Wood Waste and Field Operations

RECOMMENDATION

(All/Directors/Majority)

That the Board approve the purchase of a 2011 Hitachi ZX200 LC-3 excavator for \$120,000 plus applicable freight and taxes, subject to an inspection and test drive.

BACKGROUND

On July 15, 2021, the Board Approved a budget adjustment to accommodate the purchase of an additional excavator to assist with wood waste and seasonal projects.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the purchase of the 2011 Hitachi ZX200 LC-3 excavator (see below) located in Chase, BC, **conditioned on a successful inspection and test drive.** This machine has 3400 hours, is newly serviced and is ready for work. It is the same sized machine as our current field excavator and therefore can be transported with our existing trucks and lowbed.

Staff recommends the purchase of this machine as it falls within our budget and meets the requirements of the RDBN. It is expected that the transport of this excavator to Burns Lake will cost up to \$10,000 so the total cost for the purchase will be a maximum of \$130,000.
