Nilkitkwa Wildfire #R31465 **EVACUATION ORDER RESCINDED EVACUATION ALERT IN PLACE** July 18, 2023 at 1400 hours

Upon recommendations from BC Wildfire Service, the Evacuation Order issued July 13, 2023 at 1700 hours by Lake Babine Nation, the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako, and Recreation Sites and Trails BC has been rescinded. The Evacuation Alert issued July 18, 2023 at 1400 hours replaces the Evacuation Order and remains in place for the following area:

All properties, lands, and roads surrounding Nilkitkwa Lake including Fort Babine and Nilkitkwa Forest Service Rd. as shown on the attached map.
