- Have medication and equipment ready to leave

BE PREPARED



When on Evacuation Alert, get prepared:

- Arrange a meeting place for your family
- Gather contact information in case you are separated
- Pack a grab-and-go bag for 1 week including:
 - Clothes
 - Medications
 - Personal items
 - Eyeglasses
 - Credit cards and cash
 - Important documents including:
 - * Photo ID
 - * Keep sakes
 - Pet supplies
 - * Leashes
 - * kennels,
 - * crates and
 - * food
 - Books and games
- Make a plan for your pets – pets cannot be left locked in your house or yard
- Make sure your vehicle is full of fuel
- Check with neighbours to make sure they are ready

LIVESTOCK

If you have livestock begin evacuation when you receive an Evacuation Alert
