Upon recommendations from BC Wildfire Service, the Evacuation Order issued by Wet'suwet'en First Nation, Skin Tyee Nation, and the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako on July 19, 2023 at 1530 hours is amended for the following areas:

The Evacuation Order remains in place for Trout Creek Road, as shown on the attached map.

The Evacuation Order is rescinded for all lands and properties west of Brown Road to Morice Owen Service Road and Parrot FSR, including Owen Lake Road, east of Francois Lake (except for Trout Creek Road), as shown on the attached map.

The Evacuation Alert Amendment issued July 22, 2023 at 1300 hours by Wet'suwet'en First Nation, Skin Tyee Nation, and the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako replaces previous Evacuation Alerts and remains in place, as shown on the attached map.

Things to consider bringing with you when returning home:

- Water for 7 days
- ➢ Food for 7 days

- Full tank of gas
- Pet food & supplies

Medications

Cleaning supplies

First Aid Kit \geq

Air purifier (if available)

If you suffer from respiratory illness, consider delaying your return until air quality improves.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHILE THIS ALERT IS IN EFFECT

Be prepared for an Evacuation Order by:

- Locate all family members or co-workers and plan to meet outside the evacuation area, should an evacuation be called while separated.
- > Gather essential items such as medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e., insurance), immediate care needs for dependants and, if you choose keepsakes (photographs, etc.). Have these items readily available for quick departure.
- > Prepare to move any persons with mobility challenges and/or children.
- > Moving pets and livestock to a safe area, if you require assistance, please call the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako at 250-692-1553.
