Subject: **Purchase of a New Tractor Truck**

RECOMMENDATION: (all/directors/majority)

That the Board approve the purchase of a New 2027 Kenworth T880 Tractor Truck from Inland Truck & Equipment Ltd. for a total of \$275,712.00 plus applicable taxes.

BACKGROUND

The 2026 Environmental Services Capital Budget includes the purchase of a new tractor truck for waste hauling and low bedding operations. Waste haul trucks are used to transport waste collected at Transfer Stations to the Landfills and critical for continuity of the RDBN's waste management operation. The new tractor truck will replace one of the primary haul vehicles which has high mileage and is increasingly unreliable. The current truck will be converted to a fire protection water truck to replace the existing water truck at the Knockholt Landfill which currently is not able to pass CVSE inspection.

The current fleet of Waste Haul Trucks is shown in the table below.

The 10-year capital plan included the replacement of one waste haul truck in 2026, and this purchase will fulfill this plan. The 2026 budget allocation for this purchase is \$300,000.

EVALUATION:

The RDBN posted a Request for Quotes (RFQ) on BC Bid in June and received three (3) quotes, all of which met the required specifications and range from a 3 to 8-month delivery.

Quoted vehicles were scored on a point system as follows:

As per the evaluation criteria, staff is recommending purchasing the 2027 Kenworth T880 from Inland Truck & Equipment as it met all of the specification requirements, has a comparable service package, the shortest guaranteed delivery time and was priced within budget. The prices quoted ranged from \$269,223 to \$425,770.
