I have read your report and it is not up to date as Cam removed all the excess material stored outside so there is no need for bond to secure removal of material no longer on site. Also the current operation is mostly producing fans for the commercial hay dryers being manufactured in Vanderhoof and shipped mostly to Alberta. These units are smaller and more value added than the larger ductwork involved in sawmills the demand for which has lessened with the industry wide slowdown. This means fewer trucks in and out and a lesser volume of materials. Prior to Agrigreen Enterprises of Vanderhoof getting our clients to build the fans they were supplied from Montana. The fans when built are 5X6 feet and do not need to be shipped out with a semi truck. Agrigreen has lower shipping with our clients as a supplier. Thx john
