Fibre Lines - BC Assessment Impact

John Illes, CFO spoke with BC Assessment in regard to the taxation of fibre lines. BC Assessment indicated that fibre lines owned by local governments, not leased by a third party, are tax exempt. BC Assessment bases taxation of fibre lines on linear metres.

NEW BUSINESS

<u>CIRA Test</u>	Nellie Davis, Regional Economic Development Coordinator mentioned that the RDBN CIRA Test officially launched October 23, 2019 at the RDBN Business Forum. Ms. Davis provided an overview of the visual representation of the data on the map displaying the different levels of internet performance.
	Director Newell noted he has researched download and upload speeds in the area and very few areas have the expected CRTC broadband speeds of 50 Mbps download and 10 Mbps for upload. He spoke of funding broadband initiatives regionally.
