### **Fort Fraser Water / Wastewater Operator**

The Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako requires an operator to maintain and operate the community of Fort Fraser's Water and Wastewater Systems.

#### **General Duties of the Operator Include:**

- Operation and maintenance of the water and wastewater systems including emergency call out as required, water and wastewater quality monitoring, record keeping and reporting;
- Purchasing required materials to carry out the day-to-day operations and repairs;
- Overseeing and coordinating repair and maintenance of water and wastewater infrastructure;

#### **Nature and Scope of Position:**

- Works a flexible 10 hours per week to provide basic assessment, monitoring and general maintenance of the water and wastewater systems;
- Additional hours will be required for special repair, installation, or maintenance projects.

#### **Required Skills, Experience and Abilities:**

- Experience operating and maintaining water and wastewater systems is preferred;
- Ability to deal with the public in a positive and courteous manner;
- Ability to work independently;
- Minimum Grade 12 Education (preferred); Basic math skills;
- Assessment and reporting skills;
- Preference will be given to candidates possessing valid Small Water and Wastewater (or higher level) Certification through the Environmental Operators Certification Program;
- Valid BC Driver's Licence and vehicle appropriate for use in completion of required duties.

The Fort Fraser Water/Wastewater Operator is a permanent part time position and offers a competitive wage and vehicle use compensation package.
