
#### DISCUSSION

This application is regarding an amendment to an existing License of Occupation to allow investigative drilling and aquifer testing of underground aquifers in search of water for the Mt. Milligan Mine.

The application area is 3,638.51 ha. in size and is located approximately 80 kilometers north of Fort St. James, directly north of the Mt. Milligan Mine site.

The crown grant will allow Thompson Creek Metals the right to drill test wells at 11 sites, the majority of which are within 1 kilometer of the Nation River. Additionally, they will create three kilometers of access road, and 11 drill pads.


