RFQ: Electric Fence Construction – Vanderhoof Transfer Station

The Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako would like to complete the perimeter electric fence that encloses the Vanderhoof Transfer Station, Recycling Depot and former landfill. There is currently about 65m of chain link fence near the entrance at Dump Road, approximately 1 km of electrified 8-strand wildlife fence surrounding the former landfill and a 150m section of uncharged cattle fence that requires replacement. The fence line will be laid out by RDBN Staff as per Figure 2. Please include provisions for the supply of all labour, equipment, and materials for the following features:

- Clearing brush and small trees from the proposed fence line (Figure 2, blue line),
- Remove the existing fence from the proposed new fence line,
- Install 150m of 8 strand wildlife (bear) fence (See Figure 1),
- Replace or repair the existing fence charger,
- Ensure electrical connectivity around the entire site (when all gates are closed), and
- Inspect and repair any damage to all existing fences.
