> I have had the opportunity to learn about the proposed Crematorium/Cold Storage facility in Smithers, BC. While I understand the need for such a facility I am dismayed that the proposed location is in an established residential area.

> I understand the concerns of having this facility so near residential homes, both from a safety perspective (emissions) as well as the resulting very real potential of real estate devaluing of homes/properties.

> I have also learned of the concerns of a Holocaust survivor family member having anxiety triggered by such close proximity to the facilities's smokestacks. This person has lived in her residence for 30 years and would be facing said facility daily.
