<u>Understanding Internet Speed</u> Discrepancies

The following was discussed:

- Internet speed discrepancy information is fragmented
- Updated data will hopefully assist with new grant programs
- Provide more specific information about service
- Mapping served/unserved areas
  - o inadequate data to determine service
  - o inaccurate mapping still a challenge.

Nellie Davis, Manager of Regional Economic Development and Rowan Nagel, GIS Technician provided a presentation with the following mapping layers: the federal speed test, provincial pseudo housing and RDBN addressing.

Discussion took place regarding:

- Providing the mapping information to the province
- Advocacy regarding the federal government mapping
- Northshore of Francois Lake and Fort St. James area mapping information
- Province's mapping indicates there are homes in locations that no dwellings exist
- No mechanism to request mapping adjustments to reflect actual on the ground information
- Strategy moving forward regarding wireless and fibre applications when future projects are unknown
- Meeting with CityWest
  - direction moving forward
  - fibre first
  - o future proof technology
- Province has indicated that projects that do not receive support from local government will not move forward within the provincial/federal funding partnership announced in March 2022
  - Projects currently approved or conditionally approved retroactive to 2020
  - May change representation of houses served on the mapping
- Accurate mapping is crucial to obtain funding.
