## Do You Have a Pet Emergency Kit?

Emergencies happen. Your best strategy in dealing with a disaster is to be as prepared as possible beforehand. You should be able to take care of your pets for up to a week. Ideally, your kit should be stored in a waterproof container. You may have to stay in your home without electricity or water, or evacuate your home for a period of time.

## Prepare an Emergency Evacuation Kit for your pets containing:

Three days of food and water for each	Pet first aid kit
animal	Extra leash/harness
Disposable litter trays	Favourite toys
Litter, and/or paper towels	A photo of your pet
Disposable garbage bags	Feeding dishes
A traveling bag, crate or carrier for each pet	J
Medications and medical records	
Contact information for your veterinarian	

Make sure all your pets wear collars and/or identification tags with up-to-date information. ID tags should contain your pet's name, your phone number and any urgent medical needs.

In the event of an evacuation, <u>do not</u> leave your pets behind.
