Conducting Neighbourhood Drills

Meet your Neighbours!

Organize a get together to discuss the potential risks in your area and how they might impact your community.

Identify who in your neighbourhood has unique needs and may require extra assistance.

Discuss what skills and resources you have in your area that might be of use in an emergency. Practice household & neighbourhood emergency plans

Identify a safe meeting place in your neighbourhood where your household and your neighbours should gather in an emergency. This area is called a Muster Point. Assign responsibilities in advance to reduce confusion and enhance recovery during disaster. For example, checking on others, gathering information, or cleaning up.
