Be sure to bring items to help you with clean up and recording damages for your insurance provider. Such as mops, buckets, sponges, bleach, work gloves, hard hat, etc.

# Scene Assessment

Before entering your home, check for signs of gas leak, water around your home, or loose powerlines. Do not enter if any are noted.

# **Septic Disposal**

Do not use your sewage disposal system until you know it is capable of handling waste. If you have an outhouse, make sure it is still positioned over the hole

### Food & Medicine

If in doubt, throw it out! If you are unsure if there was any damage to your food or medicine, it is not worth risking your health. Replacing the item is the way to go.

#### Water Safety

If you're on a well or cistern, assume your water is not safe to drink. Contact your public health inspector or local authority for instructions. In the meantime, only consume water that you know to be safe.
