

# EVACUATION ALERT

## PEACOCK CREEK WILDFIRE #R21178 EVACUATION ALERT ISSUED July 27, 2023 at 1400 hours

Upon recommendations from BC Wildfire Service, an Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako due to a wildfire.

Because of the potential **danger to life and health**, the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako has issued an Evacuation Alert for the Peacock Creek Wildfire, **for all properties, lands, and dwellings south of and including the Morice Mountain Nordic Ski Club to north of and including Westview Estates Road, as shown on the attached map**. This Evacuation Alert replaces the Evacuation Order that was issued on July 17, 2023 at 0900 hours.

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation, however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHILE THIS ALERT IS IN EFFECT

Be prepared for an Evacuation Order:

- Locate all family members or co-workers and plan to meet outside the evacuation area, should an evacuation be called while separated.



# EVACUATION ORDER RESCINDED

## PEACOCK CREEK WILDFIRE #R21178 EVACUATION ORDER RESCINDED EVACUATION ALERT REMAINS IN PLACE July 27, 2023 at 1400 hours

The Evacuation Order issued on July 17, 2023 at 0900 hours by the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako is rescinded.

**The Evacuation Alert** issued on July 27, 2023 at 1400 hours by the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako **replaces the Evacuation Order and remains in place, as shown on the attached map.**

Things to consider bringing with you when returning home:

- Water for 7 days
- Food for 7 days
- Medications
- First Aid Kit
- Full tank of gas
- Pet food & supplies
- Cleaning supplies
- Air purifier (if available)

If you suffer from respiratory illness, consider delaying your return until air quality improves.

### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHILE THIS ALERT IS IN EFFECT

Be prepared for an Evacuation Order by:

- Locate all family members or co-workers and plan to meet outside the evacuation area, should an evacuation be called while separated.
- Gather essential items such as medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e., insurance), immediate care needs for dependants and, if you choose keepsakes (photographs, etc.). Have these items readily available for quick departure.
- Prepare to move any persons with mobility challenges and/or children.
- Moving pets and livestock to a safe area, if you require assistance, please call the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako at 250-692-1553.
- Arranging to transport your household members or co-workers in the event of an evacuation order. If you are asked to evacuate and need transportation assistance from the area, please call 250-692-1553.





## Peacock Creek Wildfire #R21178 EVACUATION ALERT EXPANSION July 17, 2023 at 0900 hours

Upon recommendations from BC Wildfire Service, an Evacuation Alert Expansion has been issued **due to potential danger to life and health** by the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako due to a wildfire. This expansion broadens the Evacuation Alert issued July 12, 2023 at 1330 hours is for the following area:

**All lands and properties south of Teer Rd. including Bold Rd. and extending east to the existing alert area, as shown on the attached map.**

**An Evacuation Order Amendment issued July 17, 2023 at 0900 hours remains in place.**

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation, however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.





Upon recommendations from BC Wildfire Service, an Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako due to a wildfire.

Because of the potential **danger to life and health**, the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako has issued an Evacuation Alert for the Peacock Creek Wildfire, **for all properties, lands, dwellings, and roads on Buck Flats Rd. South of Harding Rd., and properties accessed via Mountainview Dr. South of Mountainview Cemetery as shown on the attached map.**



# EVACUATION ORDER

## Peacock Creek Wildfire #R21178 EVACUATION ORDER ISSUED July 11, 2023 at 2100 hours

An Evacuation Order has been issued by the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako effective **July 11, 2023 at 2100 hours** due to a wildfire.

Because of the **danger to life and health** the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako has issued an Evacuation Order for the Peacock Creek Wildfire, **all properties and lands accessed by Buck Flats Rd., in Electoral Area G (Houston/Granisle Rural) and South of the Morice Mountain Nordic Ski Club to 2 km south of the Roses Rd. Junction as shown on the attached map.**

### **YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY AND REGISTER AT THE RECEPTION CENTRE**

**Persons who disregard this Evacuation Order and remain in the Evacuation Order area do so at their own risk. The Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako may be unable to assist anyone who remains in the Evacuation Order area.**

- If you need transportation assistance from the area, please advise the individual providing this notice or call the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako at **250-692-1553**.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Gather your family: take a neighbour or someone who needs help.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on a leash.
- Do not use more vehicles than you must.
- If you require assistance for livestock, please call the Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako at **250-692-1553**.


