  - Targets are determined in relation to ridership and demand year over year where priorities are determined and a business case can be established
- Bus replacement
  - Same size as the current buses
  - Bus ridership exceeding bus capacity and bus pass-ups of riders
    - Mr. O'Halloran indicated BC Transit continues to consider planning and projections for bus capacity and ridership
  - Current capacity of buses 30 riders
- RDBN staff have requested BC Transit consider upgrading the bus size between Vanderhoof and Prince George to address the number of pass-ups of riders
