



Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako Environmental Services Summer Student Labourer Knockholt Landfill

The Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako is hiring a Summer Student Labourer in the Environmental Services Department. This is a 40 hour per week position that begins on May 4, 2026, and ends on August 28, 2026, for a term of up to 16 weeks. Start and end dates are negotiable. The wage for this position will be \$24.43 per hour (2026 rate). This position is available at Knockholt Landfill near Houston.

This is a great opportunity for anyone looking for seasonal work, such as high school graduates and post-secondary students who have a strong interest in solid waste management and sustainability. The role offers practical, hands-on experience within a local government environmental services department and a chance to learn more about how these programs operate at the community level.

Responsibilities and Duties:

Reporting to an Operations Supervisor, the employee will assist with environmental services operations, recycling programs, and seasonal maintenance. Duties will include:

- Manual labour for construction and maintenance projects
- Assist with site and building maintenance
- Assist landfill staff with special projects
- Fence inspections and maintenance
- Brushing and weed whacking
- Litter clean-up, painting, and various other tasks
- Other duties as required

Skills and Qualifications:

- Preferred post-secondary education and familiarity in manual labour projects
- Physically fit and willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions
- Experience with motorized tools
- Safety conscious
- A self-starter with the ability to work individually and as part of a team
- Valid BC driver's license and ability to independently travel within the region as required
