



## **Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako Environmental Services Summer Student Labourer Position Burns Lake**

The Regional District of Bulkley-Nechako is hiring a Summer Student Labourer Position in the Environmental Services Department. This is a 40 hour per week position that begins on May 4, 2026, and ends on August 28, 2026. Start and end dates are negotiable. The wage for this position will be \$24.43 per hour (2026 rate). This position is based out of Burns Lake.

This is an ideal opportunity for a student enrolled in post-secondary studies with a keen interest in solid waste management and sustainable initiatives and to gain valuable hands-on experience by working within a local government environmental services department.

### **Responsibilities and Duties:**

Reporting to an Operations Supervisor, the employee will assist with environmental services operations, recycling programs, and seasonal maintenance. Duties will include:

- Manual labour for construction and maintenance projects
- Assist with building and site maintenance
- Assist the department staff with other special projects
- Brushing and weed whacking
- Litter clean-up, painting, and general maintenance
- Other duties as required

- Preferred post-secondary education and familiarity in manual labour projects
- Physically fit and willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions
- Experience with motorized tools
- Safety conscious
- A self-starter with the ability to work individually and as part of a team
